<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rights of citizen in a nation (usa) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accusing a gov't official (president) of breaking the law • 1st step in removal 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • "Corrupt Bargain" • Ends Reconstruction in the South
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Defines citizenship • State Gov't owes citizens Due Process • "Equal Protection under the Law" 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Voting Rights cannot be denied based on race or color 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Opposed slavery • Created Reconstruction laws
