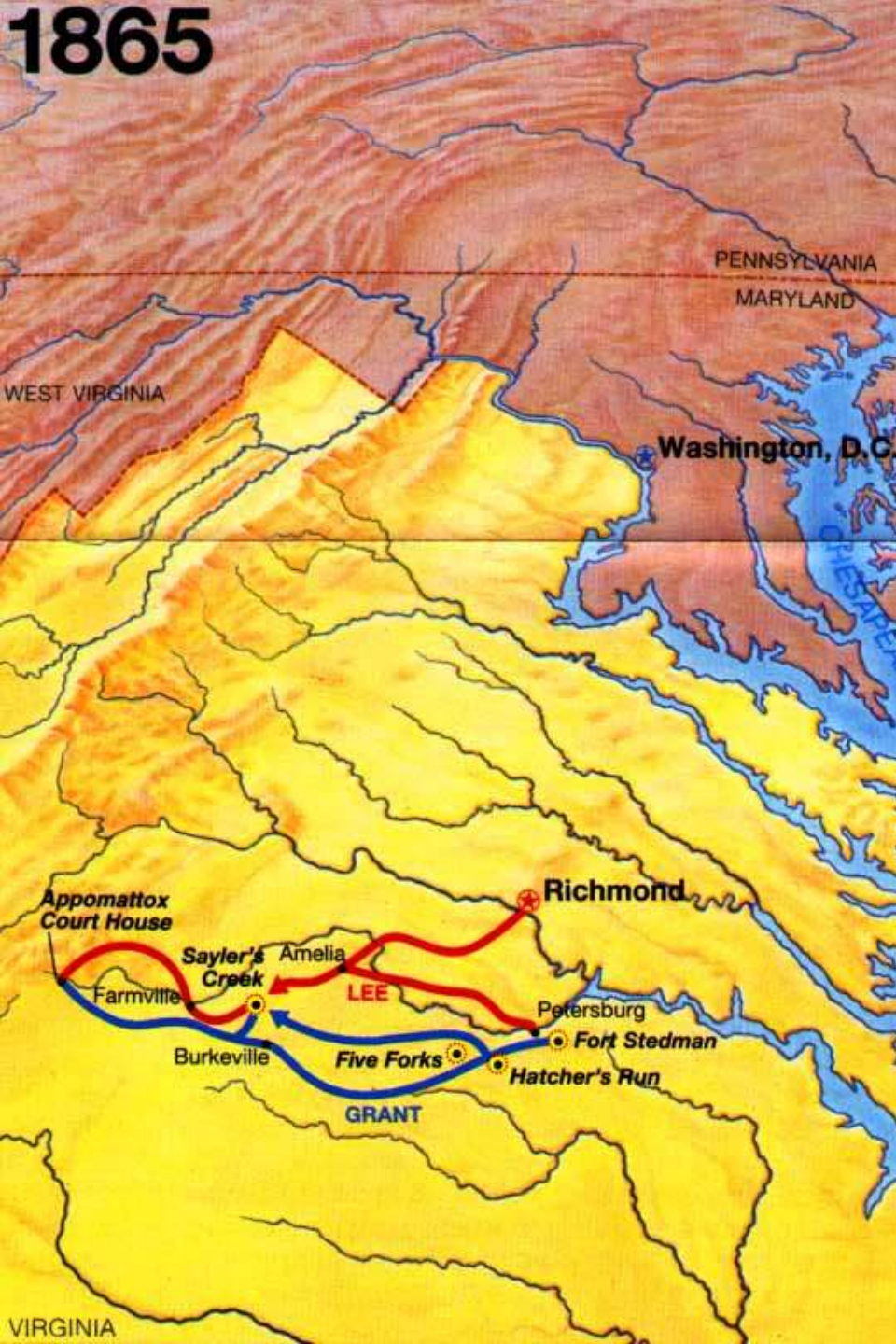

War Department, Washington, April 20, 1865.

\$100,000 REWARD!

THE MURDERER

Of our late beloved President, ABRAHAM LINCOLN,
IS STILL AT LARGE.

\$50,000 REWARD!
 will be paid by this Department for his apprehension, in addition to any reward offered by Municipal Authorities or State Executives.

\$25,000 REWARD!
 will be paid for the apprehension of JOHN H. SERRATT, one of Booth's accomplices.

\$25,000 REWARD!
 will be paid for the apprehension of DANIEL O. RABOOLE, another of Booth's accomplices.

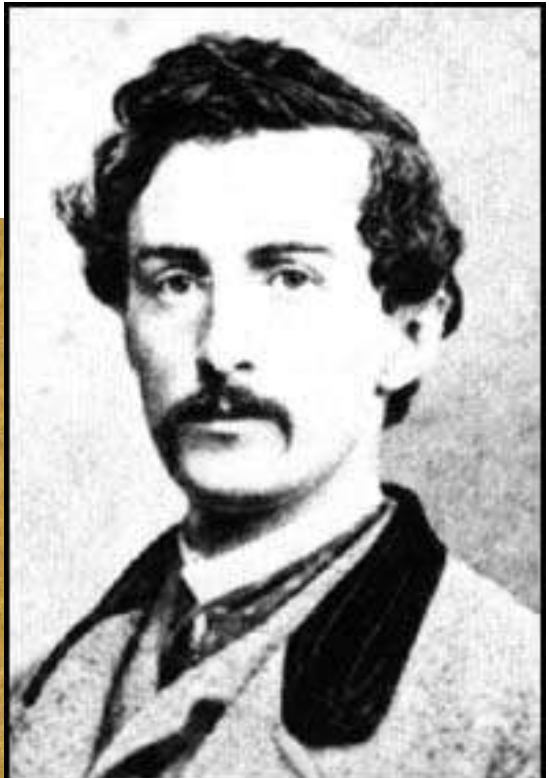
GENERAL REWARDS will be paid for any information that shall conduce to the arrest of either of the above-named criminals, or their accomplices.

All persons knowing or suspecting the said persons, or either of them, or aiding or assisting them in any way, will be treated as accessories to the murder of the President and the attempted assassination of the Secretary of State, and shall be subject to trial before a Military Commission and the punishment of DEATH.

For the class of bounty bond to be required from the land by the agent and publisher of the Government.

All news articles are required to be sold public notice on this occasion. Every one should consider this one a national duty of 1865. This notice may be printed without charge, and they will be considered as one certificate of duty of 1865.

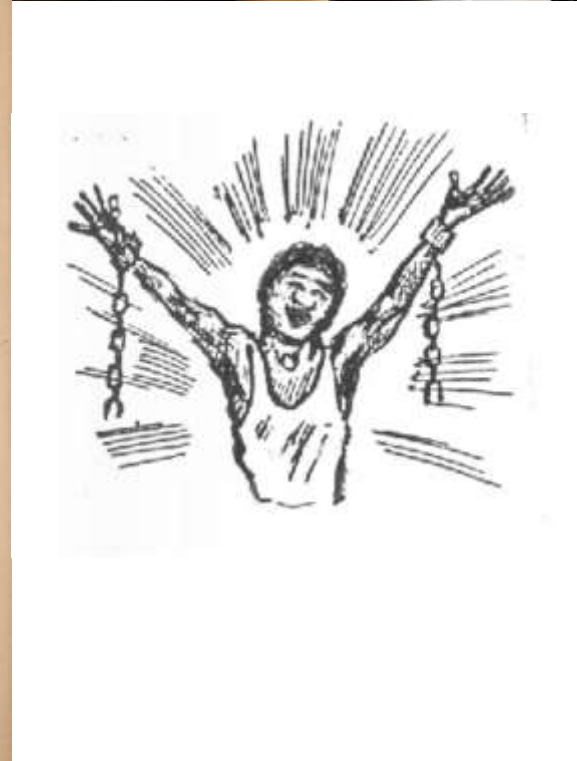
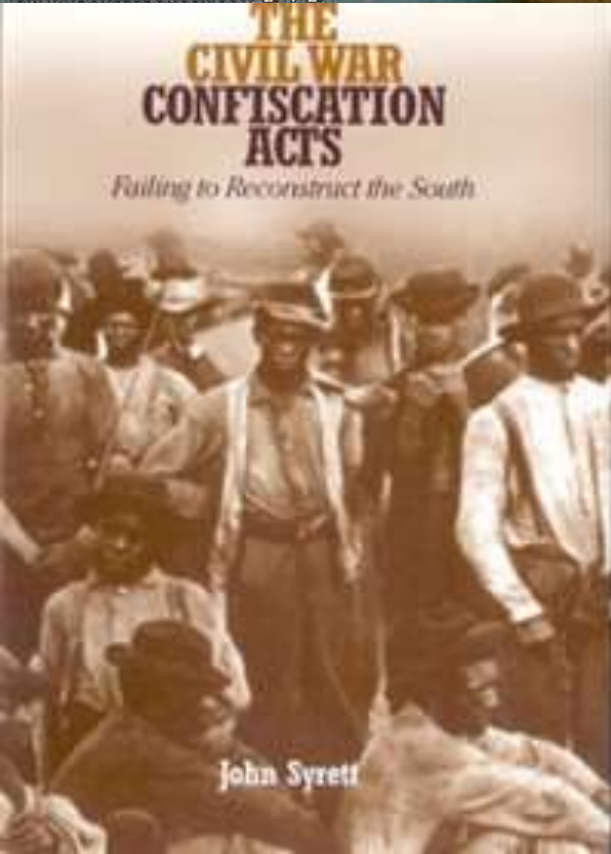
